Lost & Found: The Capital Humane Society microchips all animals before they are put up for adoption to ensure that if you ever experience the dreadful feeling of losing your beloved pet, we can help you find them. For this reason, it is important to register the microchip online. Even if your pet is not microchipped, our staff works diligently to match lost reports to incoming animal calls.

Animal Assisted Activities: Pets are beneficial to people's mental, physical and social health and well being. For this reason, volunteers routinely take available adoption pets to hospitals and retirement facilities to interact with residents and boost their morale.

Puppy Kindergarten: These classes are offered for puppies ages 2-6 months and are a great way to train your new puppy properly. The CHS will provide a basic foundation of training for a puppy to help puppies learn obedience.
